## COVID PROTOCOLS FOR WOMEN'S FORUM OF NEW YORK BREAKFAST OF CORPORATE CHAMPIONS - Nov. 10<sup>th</sup>

We wanted to update you on the COVID protocols that we have implemented for this year's [Breakfast of Corporate Champions](#) to be held on November 10th, 2021 at Cipriani 42nd Street and for the [Champions Reception and Dinner](#) the evening of November 9th, 2021 at Le Bernadin. We are meeting or exceeding all federal, state, and local guidance to ensure the safety of everyone attending and working the event.

The following COVID protocols will be enforced:

1. To gain entry to either event, all guests and staff must be fully vaccinated with a CDC approved vaccine.
  - a. "Fully vaccinated" means you are 14 days past your second dose of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine, or after 14 days of receiving the single dose of Johnson & Johnson's vaccine.
2. When you arrive, please be prepared to show proof of vaccination and a photo ID.
  - a. Acceptable forms of vaccination proof are, Excelsior Pass, Clear Pass, original vaccination card, or photo of original card.
3. You will be required to complete a health declaration when you arrive.
4. While masks will not be required inside, we encourage you to wear one until you reach your table, and anytime you leave your table.
5. Cipriani and Le Bernadin remain committed to full compliance with all New York State Department of Health guidelines pertaining to a safe environment for in-person gatherings.
  - a. Enhanced cleaning, air filtration and other protocols remain in place following the lifting of restrictions.
  - b. All employees will be fully vaccinated.
  - c. Service staff in front-of-house operational roles will continue to wear protective masks until further notice.
